We would respectfully request that the City Council revisit the City Code language concerning the PARB, to give us specific language explicitly defining the authority with which the City Council wishes to invest the PARB. Also, we would request that you change the title of the Police Advisory and Review Board to City of Pittsfield Police Advisory and Review Board.
